

Environmental Policy Statement

Hydro-X recognises that its activities have an impact on the environment, at a local, regional and global level. We will ensure that every aspect of our activities is conducted in accordance with relevant environmental regulations, laws and codes of practice as a minimum and will aim to exceed these standards where possible.

We will achieve this by:

Minimising the consumption of natural resources such as water and energy, whilst consuming material goods in moderation.

Assisting our customers to minimise consumption of natural resources, where we are in a position to do so as part of our business activities. Practical examples of this may include optimising cooling tower bleed levels, establishing rainwater harvesting systems etc.

Reducing the creation of waste by avoiding use of unnecessary packaging.

Reducing the creation of waste by reusing pallets, IBC's, 200L drums and 25L drums whenever possible.

Reducing the environmental impact of waste by recycling packaging, waste paper and card, printer cartridges and other materials whenever possible.

Ensuring all non-recyclable waste is disposed of in a safe, compliant and responsible manner. Any services used for the storage or disposal of waste will be checked to ensure the appropriate licences are upheld.

Ensuring that no polluting matter enters surface waters or groundwater, obtaining permission from the relevant water authority before discharging any contaminated water.

Reducing emissions and use of resources related to the company vehicle fleet by encouraging car-sharing where possible, operating a 'bike to work' scheme and maintaining company vehicles to the manufacturers' recommendations.

Operating to defined quality procedures.

Being fully prepared to cope with any foreseeable operational emergencies that might affect the environment.

Attempting to use suppliers who comply with the requirements of our environmental policy.

Ensuring that dust, noise and odour do not cause a nuisance to the community surrounding the place of business or site on which we are working.

Reducing the use of paper through increased introduction of electronic documentation systems.

Fostering among its staff, suppliers, customers and shareholders an understanding of environmental issues in the context of its business.

Ensuring that we are continually aware of and strive to improve the environmental impact of our activities.

By this policy Hydro-X recognises its responsibility towards protection of the environment, and issues this state as a commitment of both management and employees to minimising the environmental impact of its operations.

This policy statement was issued on 23rd April 2019 and will be reviewed within 2 years.
